

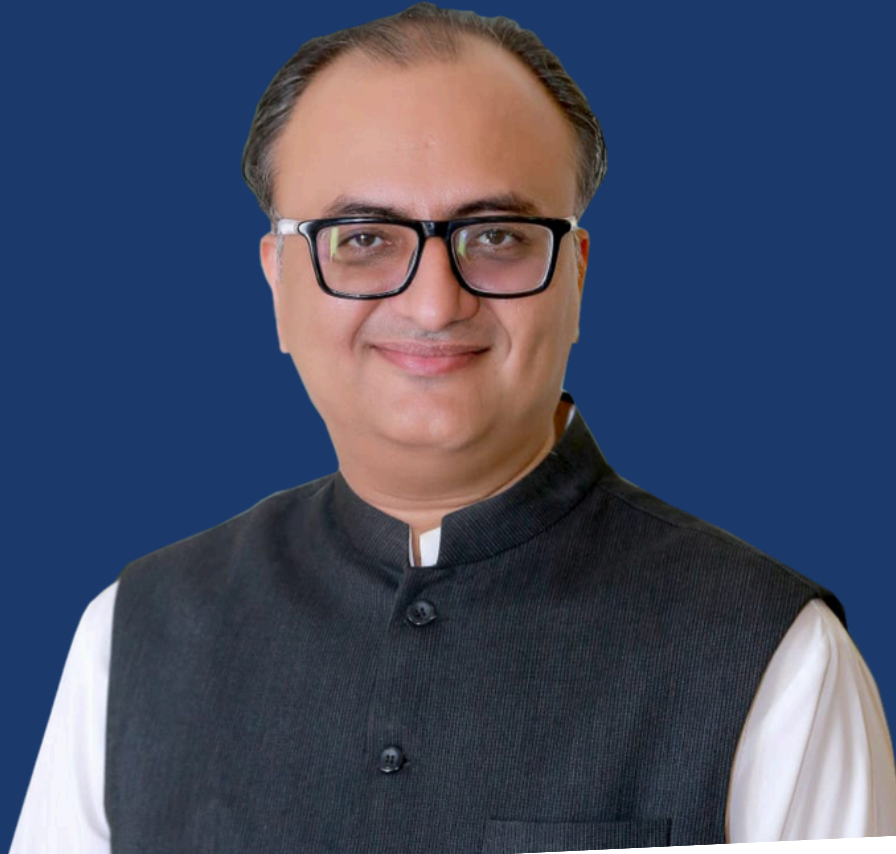

1. Introduction

Welcome to Rehan School's ACCL Foundation Level. This program is part of Rehan School, an experimental AI-first educational system designed to explore, develop, refine, and improve methods of educating students for the post-AI era. Our mission is to use Artificial Intelligence, the Internet, Social Media, Mobile Devices, Computing Power, Real-world Communication, Project-based Learning, and Self-learning Systems to maximize the confidence, communication ability, leadership, creativity, adaptability, future readiness, and earning potential of students.

By enrolling in the ACCL Foundation Level, the Parent/Guardian automatically agrees to and accepts all terms listed in this agreement.

2. Experimental Nature of the Program

The Parent/Guardian understands and accepts that Rehan School and its ACCL Foundation Level program is experimental and continuously evolving. Unlike traditional education, the program experiments with curriculum, teaching methods, AI tools, digital systems, assignments, schedules, evaluation methods, and educational philosophies. The school reserves the right to make operational, educational, technological, or structural changes without prior notice whenever deemed necessary.

3. Foundation Level Structure

The Foundation Level currently requires approximately two (2) hours of participation per day. The program may include online learning, physical classes, AI-based learning, video-based learning, internet research, communication exercises, social media exposure, digital assignments, self-learning tasks, and parent participation. The Foundation Level is designed primarily as an introduction and exposure to the Rehan School and ACCL (AI, Computer, Communication Literacy) system.

4. Existing Schooling System

Rehan School strongly advises all parents NOT to discontinue their child's existing traditional schooling system while enrolled in the Foundation Level. This program is intended to work alongside the student's current school. If the Parent/Guardian independently decides to remove the child from another school or make any educational change, then Rehan School, its founders, staff, representatives, and affiliates shall NOT be held responsible for any academic, career, or financial consequences arising from such decisions.

5. Foundation Level Does NOT Guarantee Level 1 Admission

Completion of the ACCL Foundation Level does NOT guarantee admission into Rehan School Level 1. The Foundation Level is only a pre-requirement and introductory exposure program designed to help the student, father, mother, and family understand the philosophy and approach of Rehan School.

Admission into Level 1 is highly selective and decided solely at the discretion of the Rehan School Admission Board, based on factors including but not limited to: student skill level,

communication ability, consistency, learning attitude, discipline, curiosity, parent involvement, adaptability, emotional maturity, leadership potential, and alignment with Rehan School goals and values.

Rehan School reserves the absolute right to accept, reject, delay, defer, or refuse admission to any student for any reason deemed appropriate by the Admission Board.

6. Parental Participation Requirement

The Parent/Guardian understands that Rehan School believes student transformation requires family participation. During the Foundation Level, both parents/guardians are required to study 5 hours per week with punctual attendance and complete assigned tasks, including the Foundation Level Book. Students will not be promoted to Level 1 unless their parents are also willing to learn through ACCL (AI, Computer, Communication Literacy).

7. ACCL Continuation Option

Students who are not admitted into Level 1, or who choose not to apply, may still continue learning through ACCL Level 1, Level 2, Level 3, and Level 4. These programs are designed to work alongside traditional schooling systems, requiring approximately two hours per day.

8. Technology, Internet & AI Consent

The Parent/Guardian understands and accepts that the student may use AI tools, online platforms, internet resources, social media platforms, mobile applications, video platforms, communication systems, and third-party software as part of the educational process. While Rehan School attempts to guide students responsibly, complete control over internet content and third-party platforms is not possible. Parents are strongly encouraged to supervise students independently.

9. Media, Content & Communication Consent

The Parent/Guardian understands and accepts that students may appear in photographs, videos, podcasts, online sessions, social media posts, educational materials, marketing materials, and public communication content created by Rehan School. Unless explicitly requested in writing, the School may use such content for educational, promotional, training, and communication purposes.

10. One-Month Refund Policy

Rehan AI Academy offers a one (1) month evaluation and refund period. If, for any reason, the Parent/Guardian decides within the first month from the date of enrollment that they do not wish to continue, they may cancel and receive a full refund of fees paid for the Foundation Level program.

After the completion of one (1) months from the enrollment date, no refund shall be applicable. The Parent/Guardian voluntarily waives any refund claim thereafter. The one-month period is considered sufficient time to understand the system, evaluate the methodology, observe the child's compatibility, and make an informed decision.

11. Challenges of the System

The Parent/Guardian acknowledges that the ACCL Foundation Level may not be suitable for every student. Some students may struggle with the learning style or self-learning requirements. Some parents may struggle with the expectations, communication style, pace, or experimental nature of the system. The program requires adaptability, consistency, participation, and openness to change. Dissatisfaction arising solely from the experimental nature of the system shall not be considered fraud, negligence, or misrepresentation.

12. Limitation of Liability

The Parent/Guardian agrees that Rehan School, its founders, management, staff, teachers, interns, volunteers, affiliates, and representatives shall not be held liable for educational outcomes, income outcomes, emotional adaptation issues, internet-related exposure, technology-related issues, student performance variations, dissatisfaction arising from experimental methodologies, non-selection into Level 1, or decisions independently made by the family. Participation is voluntary and based on the Parent/Guardian's own judgment.

13. Admission Termination Clause

The institution reserves the right to cancel a student's enrollment at any time if any rules or policies are violated by the student or the parents/guardians. Such decisions may be made at the sole discretion of the institution, with or without prior notice or explanation.

14. Agreement Acceptance

By enrolling in Rehan School's ACCL Foundation Level, the Parent/Guardian automatically confirms that they have read, understood, and voluntarily accepted this agreement. No physical or digital signature shall be required. Enrollment, participation, attendance, payment, or continued use of the program shall constitute acceptance. Experimental Program System

The Rehan School ACCL Foundation Level is an experimental educational program based on the lifelong learnings of Mr. Rehan Allahwala. This program aims to introduce students and families to the Rehan School system in preparation for the Level 1 to Level 8 long-term educational journey and admission pathway.

Adherence to System Rules

By enrolling your child, you agree that your child and family will follow the system, rules, and requirements of Rehan School. These rules and requirements may change in the future as technology evolves and as deemed necessary by Mr. Rehan Allahwala.

Funding and Resource Limitations

The Rehan School operates with limited financial resources. While committed to providing quality education, our ability to offer facilities and support may be constrained. Facilitators and campus heads are human and may make mistakes during this experimental process. Your understanding, patience, and cooperation are appreciated.

Parental Involvement

Both parents/guardians are required to participate in the program by studying for 5 hours per week, maintaining punctual attendance, and completing assigned tasks. This involvement is essential to the success of the educational process. Students may not be promoted to Level 1 unless their parents are also willing to learn through ACCL.

Meeting with Mr. Rehan Allahwala

A meeting with Mr. Rehan Allahwala may only be possible once Level 1 has been successfully completed by the student.

Foundation Level Structure & Daily Commitment

The Foundation Level currently requires approximately two (2) hours of participation per day. Activities may include online learning, AI-based exercises, video assignments, internet research, communication exercises, and self-learning tasks.

Student Requirements (Mandatory Equipment)

The following items are mandatory for full participation in the Foundation Level:

- A mobile phone (active on WhatsApp)
- Headphones with an extended microphone
- A laptop
- Stable internet connection
- A quiet and distraction-free environment for classes
- Punctuality and a neat, tidy appearance during all sessions

Digital Safety, Privacy & Social Media Use

- Rehan School promotes the safe and responsible use of digital platforms while respecting student privacy. Students' learning projects and selected activities may be shared on the program's official social media platforms for educational purposes.
- The program provides guidance on safe digital practices but does not monitor students' personal social media accounts or private devices.
- Parents and students are responsible for ensuring the safe and appropriate use of personal devices and social media outside the program's official platforms.

Use of Social Media — Transparency Requirement

As part of the Foundation Level learning system, students may be required to use social media platforms (Facebook, LinkedIn, YouTube, Instagram, WhatsApp, TikTok, educator.ac, paki.com, etc.) to share their learning journey publicly. By "publicly," we mean:
